Submit or postmark reports by the due date for on-time consideration. If due date falls on a weekend or holiday, Trinity recommends you submit or postmark the prior business day.

¹ Annual reports are typically due on February 15 for most sources, unless otherwise approved in writing by DEQ.

² Due date to be determined by Oregon DEQ, however per recent correspondence with inventory personnel due date will be in Quarter 2 and likely around May 1, 2024.

³ Semi-Annual reports for Title V sources will be due on July 30, unless otherwise approved in writing by DEQ.

⁴ Manufacturers (including importers) are subject to the reporting requirements based on manufacturing (including importing) activities conducted during the calendar years 2020 through 2023.

Clean Fuels Program

- ▶ Quarterly fuel transaction reports due 90 days after the conclusion of every quarter.
- ▶ Annual compliance report due April 30.

Water Quality

- ▶ Stormwater Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) due by dates listed in issued permit.
