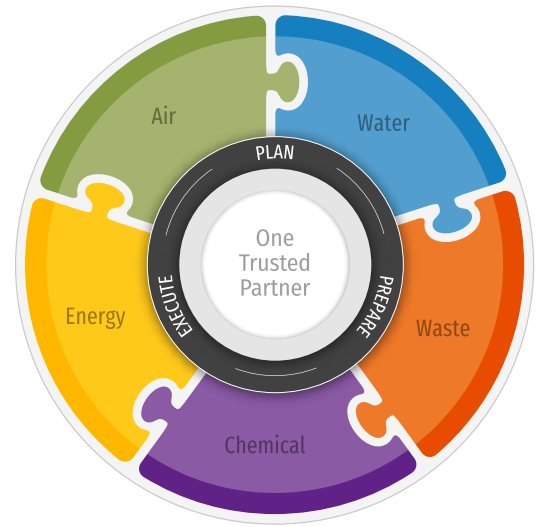

<sup>1</sup> Annual Update Report is due March 1 for sources that don't pay fees (e.g. registered sources, minor sources). For sources that pay fees (e.g. Title V sources, SM-80 sources) the Annual Update Report and Annual Emissions Inventory are due together by April 15, 2022.

<sup>2</sup> Due every even-numbered year (for example, a report due by March 1, 2024, would report activities from calendar year 2023).
