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<sup>2</sup> Manufacturers (including importers) are subject to the reporting requirements based on manufacturing (including importing) activities conducted during the reporting period. This report is required every 4 years. The last report was due in 2024. The next report will be due in 2028 (covering reporting years for 2024 through 2027).

<sup>3</sup> PFAS reporting under TSCA Section 8(a)(7) is also due in January 2026 which covers import and manufacture of PFAS from 2011 to 2022. This is a one-time data gathering and reporting requirement separate from CDR. While similar to CDR in many ways, the PFAS reporting is much more extensive and does not exclude articles, de minimis concentrations, or low levels of activity.
