**Note:** This is not an exhaustive list of reporting deadlines. Facility-specific requirements and deadlines may vary. Trinity suggests checking with local regulators for submission deadlines. Submit or postmark reports by the due date for on-time consideration. If due date falls on a weekend or holiday, Trinity recommends you submit or postmark the prior business day.

<sup>1</sup> VSQGs or SQGs that for any one calendar month generate 2,200 pounds or more of hazardous waste, must also submit a biennial report (unless an episodic event notice had been submitted).

<sup>2</sup> Michigan EGLE converted from MAERS to MiEnviro for reporting beginning in January 2024.

<sup>3</sup> EPA has proposed moving the 2025 GHGRP deadline to June 10, 2026 and eliminating most reporting requirements after 2024 (with Subpart W suspended until 2034).
