Submit or postmark reports by the due date for on-time consideration. If due date falls on a weekend or holiday, Trinity recommends you submit or postmark the prior business day.

¹ EPA has proposed moving the 2025 GHGRP deadline to June 10, 2026 and eliminating most reporting requirements after 2024 (with Subpart W suspended until 2034). Until finalized, current March 31 deadlines remain in effect. See details at [Rulemaking Notices for GHG Reporting | US EPA](#).

⁷ PFAS reporting under TSCA Section 8(a)(7) is currently due on October 13, 2026, and covers the import and manufacture of PFAS from 2011 to 2022. This is a one-time data-gathering and reporting requirement that is separate from CDR. In November 2025, USEPA proposed revisions to the reporting requirements and the report submission period. If finalized as proposed, the submission window would open 60 days after the effective date of the final revised rule and remain open for three months.
