Submit or postmark reports by the due date for on-time consideration. If due date falls on a weekend or holiday, Trinity recommends you submit or postmark the prior business day.

¹ Annual reports are typically due on February 15 for most sources, unless otherwise approved in writing by DEQ.

² Semi-Annual reports for Title V sources are due on Feb 15 and July 30, unless otherwise approved in writing by DEQ.

³ EPA has proposed moving the 2025 GHGRP deadline to June 10, 2026 and eliminating most reporting requirements after 2024 (with Subpart W suspended until 2034). Until finalized, current March 31 deadlines remain in effect. See details at [Rulemaking Notices for GHG Reporting | US EPA](#).

Clean Fuels Program

- ▶ Quarterly fuel transaction reports due 90 days after the conclusion of every quarter.
- ▶ Annual compliance report due April 30.

Water Quality

- ▶ Quarterly Stormwater Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) due by dates listed in issued permit.
